

Things to Remember

WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU GET IN AN AUTO ACCIDENT:

- **1.** Check yourself and passengers for injury.
- **2.** Call 911. Report the accident, injuries, and request police.
- **3.** Check for traffic before stepping out of your vehicle.
- **4.** Exchange information with other drivers using the form.
- **5.** Document the accident. Photograph damages, injuries, where vehicles stopped, skid marks and road conditions. Speak to any witnesses and get their contact information.
- 6. Provide police officers at the scene with an official statement.
- 7. Seek medical treatment.AccidentCarenow.com locations sees auto accident victims immediately. <u>If you are critically injured</u>, paramedics should transport you directly to a hospital.
